



Biological Fruitfulness for the Married

Prophetic Declaration

- ***All waiting and expectant married women, I am glad to let you know that this month is your time of visitation! You will carry your babies in your womb and hold them in your hands, in Jesus' mighty name.***
- It's your season, Be fruitful in Jesus' name - (Psalm 62:11)

Key Texts

1. Psalm 127 vs. 3 " Lo, children are a heritage of the LORD: and ***the fruit of the womb is his reward***"
2. ***Ps 113:9: - He gives the childless woman a family, making her a happy mother. Praise the Lord!***
3. Deuteronomy 7:14: ***Thou shalt be blessed above all people: there shall not be male or female barren among you, ...***

The Command

1. Genesis 1:28: - .. And God blessed them, and God said unto them, **Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, ..**

Prayer Points

1. **Covenant of fruitfulness and childbearing:** Lord in the name of your only begotten son - Jesus Christ, I **entered with my spouse and children who are waiting for the fruit of the womb into the Covenant of fruitfulness that you stroke with Abraham and Sarah by faith.**
2. By faith in Christ Jesus, my spouse and I, together with our children who are waiting on you for the blessing of the womb, receive your divinely ordained access to flourish like the palm tree and to grow like the cedar in Lebanon.
3. All married women in this church and in our households receive the power to bring forth the fruit of the womb by God's commanded authority in Jesus' mighty name (Psalm 92:12, 14)
4. Father Lord, bless our bread and water; take sickness, bareness and fruitlessness away from our household. Let nothing cast their young, nor be barren, in our land in Jesus' mighty name.
5. **2 Kings 4:16-17: The Shunammite woman** served you with her resources and you blessed her with a son. Heavenly Father, according to your word in Exodus 23:25-26, I decree that all members of this church and our households receive the grace and power to seek and serve you with all our resources. I pray that you bless us with the fruit of the womb in Jesus' mighty name.
6. Dear Father, **Abraham obeyed you** and walked in divine guidance and you struck a covenant of fruitfulness with him and his seed forever, we surrender to your divine leading, guidance, and instruction. We ask grace for obedience,
7. Father, you are our sun and shield: give us the grace and the glory of fruitfulness in our homes, let this not be delayed any further. We receive our blessings now (Psalms 84:11).
8. Father, bless **our homes in keeping with the covenant of fruitfulness and the fruit of the womb in Jesus' mighty name.**
9. **It is our season of fruitfulness!** Lord, honour the childless married women in their homes; make them joyful mothers of children in Jesus' mighty name.

Closing Script

- A. We have sown in tears, and we are reaping in joy. We have gone forth weeping, bearing seed and sowing them; and we are doubtlessly coming this season with rejoicing (Psalm 126:5-6).
- B. We are returning with a great harvest and all eyes will see and rejoice. Be Ye Fruitful in Jesus' name.
